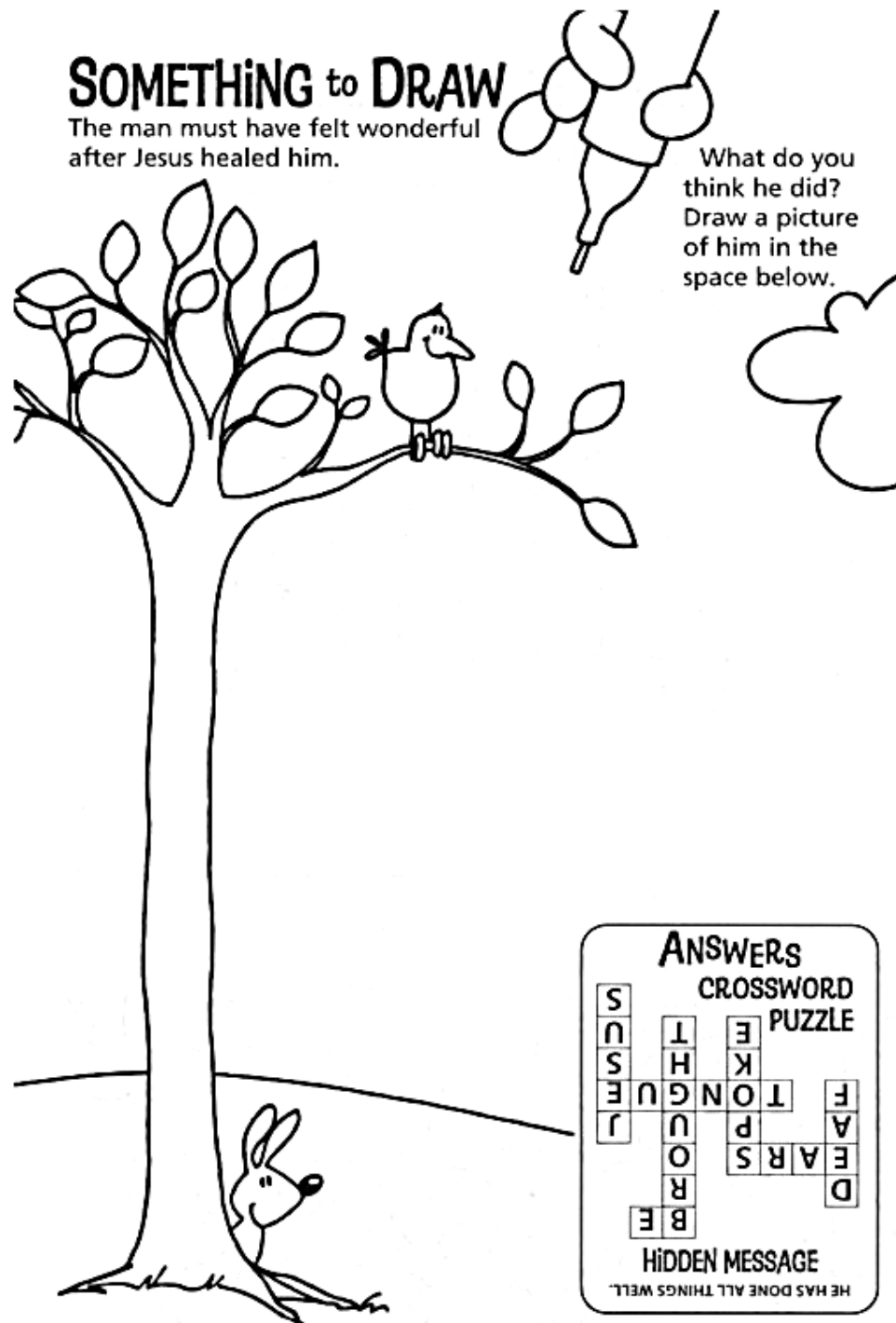


# SOMETHING to DRAW

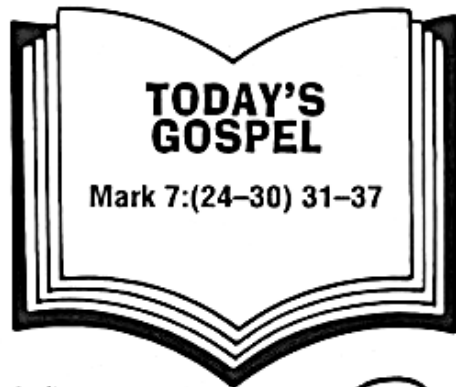
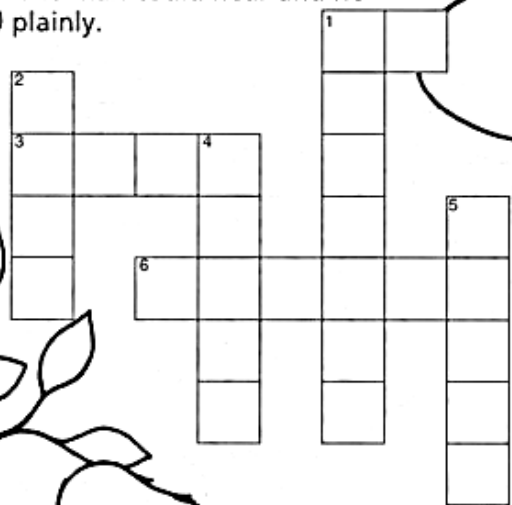

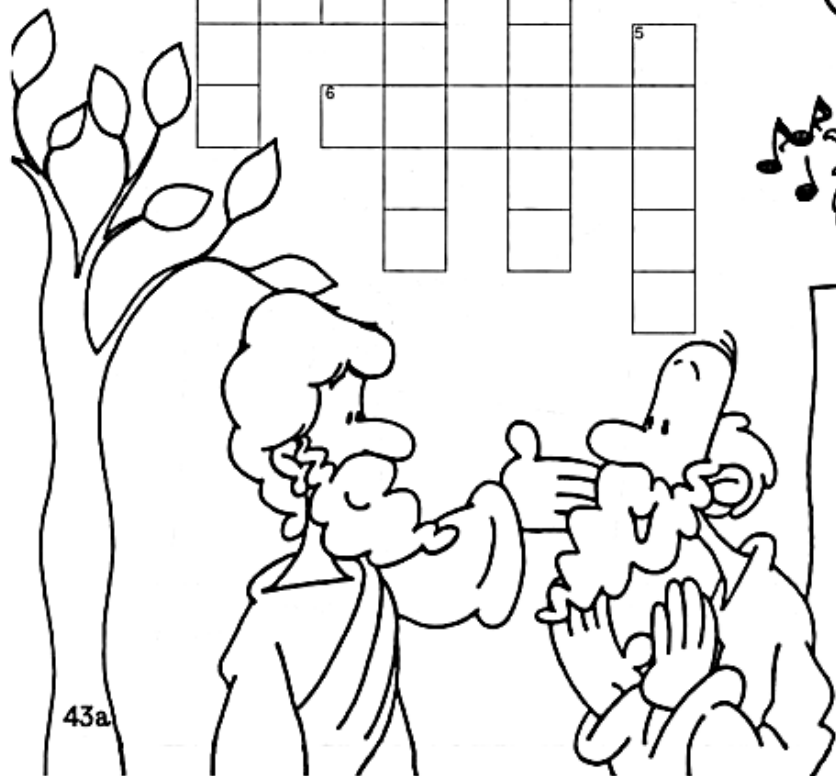
# CROSSWORD PUZZLE
